

# Free multi-colored puppy crochet pattern



## Supplies:

Performance Yarn: Cotton Passion (50 g./  
85 m.; Nm 14/8 -100% cotton)

## Colours and quantity

0235 (blue) – 23 g.

0285 (yellow) – 36 g.

0121 (orange) – 20 g.

0202 (purple) – 6 g.

0224 (red) – 18 g.

0243 (green) – 14 g.

0261 (beige) – 6 g.

0 mm crochet hook

Fiberfill

Scissors and sewing needle

Stitch marker

## Abbreviation:

Ch – chain

St – stich

Sc – single crochet

Sl st – slip stich

Inc – increase (2 sc in one st)

Dec – decrease (2 sc together)

[...] – total number of stitches at the end  
of the round

(...) – repeat the space in brackets till the  
end of the round or the given number of  
times



## Cotton Passion

## 1. HEAD

Begin crocheting with yellow yarn.

Rnd 1: ch 3 join with a sl st

Rnd 2: 3 triple inc (three stitches in every stitch) – [9]

Mark the beginning of each round with a stitch marker

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) – [12]

Rnd 4: (1 sc, inc) – [18]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) – [24]

Rnd 6: (3sc, inc) – [30]

Rnd 7: 30 sc

## 2. NOSE

Begin crocheting with beige yarn.

Rnd 1: ch 3, join the ends with a sl st.

Rnd 2: 3 triple inc (three stitches in every stitch) – [9]

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) – [12]

Rnd 4: (1 sc, inc) – [18]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) – [24]

Rnd 6: (3sc, inc) – [30]

Rnd 7 – Rnd 11: 30 sc

Fill the nose with fiberfill and attach to the head.

Rnd 8: (4 sc, inc) – [36]

Rnd 9: (5 sc, inc) – [42]

Rnd 10: (6 sc, inc) – [48]

Rnd 11: (7 sc, inc) – [54]

Rnd 12 – Rnd 20: 54 sc

Rnd 21: (7 sc, dec) – [48]

Rnd 22: (6 sc, dec) – [42]

Rnd 23: (5 sc, dec) – [36]

Rnd 24: (4 sc, dec) – [30]

Rnd 25: (3 sc, dec) – [24]

NOTE: Stuff with fiberfill

Rnd 26: (2 sc, dec) – [18]

Rnd 27: (sc, dec) – [12]

Refill with fiberfill if needed

Rnd 28: (dec) repeat 6 times

Fasten off the yarn, leaving a small tail. Thread the needle and pass it through the front loops of the rest 6 stitches then pull to close the hole. Weave in the end.

## 4. BODY

Use orange yarn

Rnd 1 ch 3, join the ends with a sl st.

Rnd 2 3 triple inc (three stitches in every stitch) – [9]

Rnd 3 (2 sc, inc) – [12]

Rnd 4 (1 sc, inc) – [18]

Rnd 5 (2sc, inc) – [24]

Rnd 6 (3sc, inc) – [30]

Rnd 7 30 sc

Use black yarn to embroider a nose, eyebrows and eyes. Use white yarn for the light reflection on the eyes, and red yarn for the mouth.

## 3. EARS

Use purple yarn

Rnd 1: ch 6

Rnd 2: 6 sc

Rnd 3: 6 sc

Rnd 4: inc, 4 sc, inc – [8]

Rnd 5 – Rnd 7: 8 sc

Rnd 8: inc, 6 sc, inc – [10]

Rnd 9 – Rnd 13: 10 sc

Rnd 14: dec, 6 sc, dec – [8]

Make a border of sc along the contour of the ear. Crochet two ears and attach them to the head with yellow yarn.

## 5. TAIL

Use green yarn.

Rnd 1: ch 3, join the ends with a sl st.

Rnd 2: 3 triple inc (three stitches in every stitch) – [9]

Rnd 3 – Rnd 6: 9 sc

Rnd 7: (2 sc, inc) – [12]

Rnd 8 – Rnd 10: 12 sc

Rnd 11: (2 sc, inc) – [16]

Stuff with fiberfill and attach to the body.

Rnd 8 (4 sc, inc) – [36]

Rnd 9 (5 sc, inc) – [42]

Rnd 10 (6 sc, inc) – [48]

Rnd 11 – Rnd 18: 48 sc

Change color to blue

Rnd 19 – Rnd 28: 48 sc

Change color to black

Rnd 29 – Rnd 36: 48 sc

Rnd 37 (6 sc, dec) – [42]

Rnd 38 (5 sc, dec) – [36]

Rnd 39 (4 sc, dec) – [30]

Rnd 40 (3 sc, dec) – [24]

Stuff firmly with fiberfill, and make sure to distribute it well.

Rnd 41 (2 sc, dec) – [18]

Rnd 42 (sc, dec) – [12]

Rnd 43 6 dec – [6]

Fasten off the yarn, leaving a small tail. Thread the needle and pass it through the front loops of the rest 6 stitches then pull to close the hole. Finish with red yarn.

## 7. BACK PAWS

Start with orange yarn.

Rnd 1: ch 3, join both ends with a sl st.

Rnd 2: 3 triple inc (three stitches in every stitch) – [9]

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) – [12]

Rnd 4: (1 sc, inc) – [18]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) – [24]

Rnd 6: (3sc, inc) – [30]

## 6. FRONT PAWS

Begin with yellow yarn.

Rnd 1: ch 3, join the ends with a sl st.

Rnd 2: 3 triple inc (three stitches in every stitch) – [9]

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) – [12]

Rnd 4: (1 sc, inc) – [18]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) – [24]

Rnd 6: (3sc, inc) – [30]

Rnd 7 – Rnd 9: 30 sc

Change color to green

Rnd 10 – Rnd 16: 30 sc

## 8. RIBBON

Use the red yarn to crochet a chain of 70 – 80 stitches. Cut the yarn at the end and make a knot at both ends of the chain. Tie the ribbon around the puppy's neck.

Here you have your puppy ready!

Rnd 7 – Rnd 9: 30 sc

Change color to blue

Rnd 10 – Rnd 16: 30 sc

Stuff the four paws with fiberfill and attach symmetrically to the body.

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
